

Workplace Giving is a simple and effective way for employees to regularly donate to charity organisations that are entitled to receive tax deductible donations.

Easily set up through your payroll system, employees can make regular donations from their pre-tax pay. Generally, the donation amount is a fixed amount deducted from your employees' salary or wages on each pay day. You then pay the donation directly to the charity.

The Workplace Giving program does not affect the way gross income, super guarantee payments or fringe benefits are worked out.

- It allows you to make smaller donations spread over the year, rather than a larger one-off donation.
- Donations are taken care of by the employee eliminating the need to arrange cash, cheques or set up direct debits.
- The donations are made from your pre-tax salary which means you receive the tax benefit immediately and there is no need to request receipts or substantiate the donations for tax purposes later.
- The system is easy to opt in and out of, giving you full control over their giving.

HOW?

FOR EMPLOYERS

- The administration can be undertaken as part of normal payroll procedures. Modern payroll systems are able to accommodate payroll giving. There are no tax forms to complete and the records required are straight forward.
- Importantly, Foodbank SA is a registered charitable organisation. Foodbank will provide the bank details and contact details in order to set Foodbank up as a vendor in your payroll system.
- Using the completed Work Place Giving Form, set-up pretax payments to Foodbank. Please ensure you use the 'FBSA Unique code' as reference. Include this summary in your employees PAYG summary.

FOR EMPLOYEES

- Simply complete the Foodbank Work Place Giving form.
- Email to Foodbank SA we will then provide you with your unique reference number.
- Submit your form complete with your reference number to your organisations payroll.
